

Sorry for the delay (I had several meetings this am).

Here are some responses to your questions below:

- Walker only operates 1 landfill which is the South Landfill in Niagara. We do not own/operate landfills elsewhere in or outside of Niagara.
- Generally speaking, approximately 75% of waste generated in Niagara is currently managed by the South Landfill. This includes a portion of residential/curbside waste which is collected by the Region as well as commercial and institutional waste (i.e. businesses, schools, offices, etc.).
 - For additional context the waste the Region collects (residential/curbside) is managed by 3 landfills in Niagara. These are Walker's South Landfill and the Regions Humberstone Landfill in Welland and Regional Road 12 in Grimsby. This is what Geordie referenced last night during his remarks.
- Approximately 13% of waste generated in Niagara is exported to New York state to a landfill in Lewiston. The remaining approximately 13% is managed by the Region's landfill as noted above.
- I've attached an info sheet for additional information.

If you'd like to chat more about waste generation/recycling (i.e. I call it Waste 101), I'd be more than happy to. For reference, a common misconception is that the waste generated at home (residential) is the only part of ones 'waste footprint'. In reality, we generate waste at 1) home 2) work 3) and play; each is approximately 33%. I use the analogy of waste generated at an office (i.e. work) or when you go to a hockey game or movies and buy a hot dog and pop (i.e. play) in addition to the bag one puts out at the curb for bi-weekly pickup. Again, happy to chat more if you like.





ONTARIO'S RECYCLING & DISPOSAL RATES



Hello and thank you for contacting us and providing input into the Environmental Assessment (EA) for Phase 2 of our South Landfill. I've reviewed your comments and am able to provide some responses and additional information. I've itemized your comments below:

1. Send information about future virtual meetings

- Response:
 - Sorry that we weren't able to attend our Open House on Dec. 14th. To ensure the information was available for all interested members of the public, we are providing a virtual version of the event which you can find at https://southlandfillphase2.com/virtual-open-house. You can review the information and provide feedback until January 15th, 2024. The Open House event materials will also be archived on our project website.
 - You can subscribe for updates through our main project page at https://southlandfillphase2.com/. Alternatively, with your permission, our team can make note of your e-mail address and add it to our contact list for future project updates.
 - Walker values community input and we will provide public consultation opportunities at key milestones throughout this planning process. Lastly – feel free to contact me directly anytime.

2. Encroachment of naturalized areas surrounding the existing quarry/future landfill

- Response:
 - One of the key reasons Walker has identified the quarry as a suitable candidate for the
 development of the next phase of the South Landfill is that it is a current existing industrial
 land use and this minimizes the need to develop green space such as agricultural lands or
 forested areas.
 - The current concept for the project does not envision any significant disturbance to forested areas outside of the existing quarry footprint.
 - As part of the EA, many studies will be done including an ecological (terrestrial and aquatic) study to minimize impact to the natural environment.
 - Reforestation and naturalization plays an important role in Walker's long-term vision of its properties and we will look at opportunities to increase forest canopy, habitat and ecological diversity on buffer lands around the project site.

3. Suggested north/south corridor for wildlife movement

- Response:
 - As noted above, as this planning process progresses, the development of detailed plans
 (i.e. buffer land uses, end use of the landfill once capped and closed) will occur and we'll
 note your feedback regarding habitat diversity and wildlife corridors (noting connectivity to
 the escarpment lands to the north of the project site).
 - There will be additional opportunities for review/feedback as the process moves forward.

4. Underutilized/unutilized land should be naturalized

- Response:
 - Walker has an ongoing program to evaluate land use and identify opportunities for improvement. Some recent examples include the transitioning of marginal farmland back to a naturalized state (forest, meadow, etc). We work closely with community partners such as Niagara College, Vineland Research and Indigenous communities to identify opportunities for land improvement opportunities that help meet the needs of the community.

5. Presence of Species-at-Risk and proposed mitigation measures

- Response:
 - As part of the EA, the ecological study will identify the presence of any Species-at-Risk and mitigation/management options (such as habitat improvement).

6. Leachate Management & Treatment

- Response:
 - Ontario laws/regulations for landfill operations require landfills to capture leachate (via bottom liner systems and leachate collection systems) so it can be treated. This is the case with our currently operating Phase 1 of the South Landfill. More information can be found on our project website.
 - As part of the EA, we will be assessing treatment options which include system capacities and other considerations such as storage during precipitation events, etc.

7. Planning for the landfill should work in tandem with increasing composting efforts

- Response:
 - Agree. Walker composts all of the Green Bin organic materials from Niagara Region at its Resource Management Campus in Niagara Falls (where the South Landfill is also located). We work closely with the Region and the community at large to help raise awareness (talks in school, community events and outreach, etc.) of the importance of using green bin as well as blue and grey bin programs. Over the last year, Walker has invested significantly and expanded our compost facilities to support increased diversion of organic materials. The end-product, compost is then used to return vital nutrients and organic matter back to the land. Walker is actually the largest composter of food waste in Canada. Here's a link to some info you might find interesting https://walkerind.com/sustainability-2022/
 - Organic matter that ends up in the landfill creates landfill gas which Walker collects and uses to generate renewable electricity and natural gas which reduce Niagara's reliance on fossil based energy sources. Currently, we generate the equivalent amount of renewable energy at our Niagara Campus to power 25,000 homes.

8. Suggestion to use clear garbage bags to encourage composting

- Response:
 - Thank you. This is a great idea to increase participation in the Region's Green Bin program.
 We will share this feedback with staff at the Niagara Region as well as local elected officials.

I was not able to attend the Public Meeting on the waste facility that Walker had a few weeks ago. Please send me any links or notices about future virtual meetings.

There are a few matters that I would like to comment about at the outset. First one of the good things about the existing quarry that is going to be converted into a landfill, is that there is an existing forest that was planted as a buffer. I hope that this forest and other existing natural areas that serve as a buffer will not be encroached upon by the new landfill.

It is to be hoped that in addition to a mere buffer, the opportunity will be taken to have a north south corridor through the length of the new facility in in proximity to existing buffers for wildlife movement. Any land that is not needed for landfill purposes, should be put into some form of natural habitat. While forests are the norm for this area, the exact nature of the habitat could be determined through a process of public consultation. Studies should be published to demonstrate what Species At Risk currently exist in the area, so that the buffer can be designed to improve their habitat.

The new landfill should have facilities to collect any leachate which should be directed to the sewage treatment system. This needs to be carefully designed to avoid overloading this system, perhaps with shut off valves to prevent discharges during precipitation events.

Planning for the landfill needs to be done in connection with having better programs to reduce compostable waste. Niagara's rate of waste reduction is significantly less than the most successful municipality in the province, Markham. One way of reducing compostable waste is to have clear bags, which produces moral suasion against putting compostable material into garbage bags. Compostable material in garbage is the biggest source of leachate.

You've provided input on really important issues and I've attempted to provide a thorough response with additional context. I would be more than willing to schedule a time to discuss your comments further recognizing that there is much to discuss on these topics.

I've itemized your comments below for clarity/ease of reference.

Comment - The documentation associated with the Terms of Reference appear to be thorough, although the public needs to be assured that the assessment, evaluation, and monitoring activities are actually carried out as stated.

Response – The Terms of Reference (ToR), once approved by the Minister of the Environment, is a very important document in the Environmental Assessment (EA) process. It becomes a series of commitments (i.e., evaluation, assessment, and monitoring methodologies) that Walker must satisfy throughout the course of EA. If Walker fails to meet the requirements set out in the ToR once approved, the Final EA Report will be rejected by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP). Additionally, as part of the Final EA Report, Walker will produce a table that illustrates how the commitments made in the ToR were satisfied. Based on your feedback, we'll ensure this table clearly demonstrates (i.e. easy to understand, references where the reader can find the required information) to the public that Walker has fulfilled the commitments.

Comment - The acceptance of toxic and/or near toxic materials, including Durham Region's 'fly ash'. I understand that this is deemed "non-hazardous", however independent third party testing for mercury, arsenic, copper, and chromium within the LSA is required.

Response – Stabilized fly ash from the Durham York Energy Centre (DYEC) that is accepted at our South Landfill (Phase 1) is analyzed by independent, third parties (i.e., qualified professionals and accredited laboratories) using MECP approved methodologies. The analysis conducted currently includes mercury, arsenic, and chromium. Additional information on the DYEC Ash Sampling and Testing Protocol can be found here. This protocol meets Walker's solid, non-hazardous waste acceptance criteria set out in the Environmental Compliance Approval as required by the MECP.

Comment - Water/soil contamination from landfill liquids leaching into and polluting existing groundwater, surface water and land. I understand that Walker's landfill areas are specially lined to prevent water from escaping the property, however I have my doubts. The appropriate testing by independent third parties with the LSA is absolutely required.

Response – Ontario has very strict regulations that protect surface and groundwater. Specifically, O. Reg. 232/98 requires landfills to include liner systems that are fully protective of the environment. Information on the liner system design that is currently used at Walker's South Landfill Phase 1 can be found on our project website (<u>link</u>). The design and construction quality assurance (i.e., monitoring and testing during liner installation) of the liner system is carried out by independent third parties. Proof of this independent oversight is provided to the MECP before a landfill is approved to receive any waste.

Further, independent third parties provide annual monitoring (i.e., surface water and groundwater monitoring) in and around the landfill site. These results are published in an Annual Monitoring Report which is submitted to the MECP for review.

Comment - The levels of methane and other VOCs that are not captured as RNG by Walker. As the City of Thorold attempts to lower its GHGs, Walker emissions must also decrease, not increase over time. Where is Walker's plan to cut the facility's GHG emissions in half by 2030?

Response – I would be happy to discuss Walker's efforts to reduce GHG emissions and support the transition to a low carbon economy in more detail. In the interim, here are few examples for reference:

- Fuel efficiency optimization and electrification of our mobile equipment fleet,
- Creating sustainable products like <u>Grow Better Gardens</u> which replace peat in soil products with compost from municipal food waste programs (e.g. recovering food waste, protecting wetlands/peat bogs, sequestering carbon in soil),
- Producing Low Carbon Alternative Fuels (LCAF) from wood that would otherwise go to landfill to help steel mills/large emitters reduce their reliance on coal/GHG intensive fuels,
- Recovering landfill gas and producing renewable energy to help reduce Niagara's reliance on non-renewable energy sources.

With regard to your inquiry about landfill methane that is not captured by our landfill gas-to-energy system, we are highly motivated to minimize these emissions. Walker has been actively capturing landfill gas, converting it_into renewable energy sources, and displacing non-renewable energy sources for over 20 years in Niagara.

First, we are closely following the federal government's proposed landfill methane regulations, which I believe you reference above (i.e., "50% reduction by 2030"). While these regulations largely focus on landfills without gas collection systems, it will also ensure modern and progressive sites like Walker's are minimizing methane emissions. To further reduce any methane emissions from our site, we have been working closely with leading academic institutions and conducting research on advanced remote methane sensing techniques (i.e., drones) to improve monitoring, as well as the development of enhanced landfill cap designs that oxidize any methane that attempts to escape from the landfill.

Secondly, any methane that escapes into the atmosphere is a lost economic opportunity for Walker and the community. The methane we capture is turned into renewable energy that is used to:

- produce Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) and sell it into the Enbridge distribution network,
- generate renewable electricity to power Walker's Campus and sell it into the Niagara Peninsula Energy system, and
- deliver energy to the GM Glendale Plant to provide heat and electricity to this facility

Capturing methane forms a large component of our business and we, along with our community partners, are aligned in maximizing the collection of methane generated in our landfill to generate renewable energy.

Hello again,

Thank you for your patience; I'm happy to provide responses to the feedback you've shared with us on the Draft Terms of Reference for the South Landfill Phase 2 project. You've provided input on really important issues and I've attempted to provide a thorough response with additional context. I would be more than willing to schedule a time to discuss your comments further recognizing that there is much to discuss on these topics.

I've itemized your comments below for clarity/ease of reference.

Comment - The documentation associated with the Terms of Reference appear to be thorough, although the public needs to be assured that the assessment, evaluation, and monitoring activities are actually carried out as stated.

Response – The Terms of Reference (ToR), once approved by the Minister of the Environment, is a very important document in the Environmental Assessment (EA) process. It becomes a series of commitments (i.e., evaluation, assessment, and monitoring methodologies) that Walker must satisfy throughout the course of EA. If Walker fails to meet the requirements set out in the ToR once approved, the Final EA Report will be rejected by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP). Additionally, as part of the Final EA Report, Walker will produce a table that illustrates how the commitments made in the ToR were satisfied. Based on your feedback, we'll ensure this table clearly demonstrates (i.e. easy to understand, references where the reader can find the required information) to the public that Walker has fulfilled the commitments.

Comment - The acceptance of toxic and/or near toxic materials, including Durham Region's 'fly ash'. I understand that this is deemed "non-hazardous", however independent third party testing for mercury, arsenic, copper, and chromium within the LSA is required.

Response – Stabilized fly ash from the Durham York Energy Centre (DYEC) that is accepted at our South Landfill (Phase 1) is analyzed by independent, third parties (i.e., qualified professionals and accredited laboratories) using MECP approved methodologies. The analysis conducted currently includes mercury, arsenic, and chromium. Additional information on the DYEC Ash Sampling and Testing Protocol can be found here. This protocol meets Walker's solid, non-hazardous waste acceptance criteria set out in the Environmental Compliance Approval as required by the MECP.

Comment - Water/soil contamination from landfill liquids leaching into and polluting existing groundwater, surface water and land. I understand that Walker's landfill areas are specially lined to prevent water from escaping the property, however I have my doubts. The appropriate testing by independent third parties with the LSA is absolutely required.

Response – Ontario has very strict regulations that protect surface and groundwater. Specifically, O. Reg. 232/98 requires landfills to include liner systems that are fully protective of the environment. Information on the liner system design that is currently used at Walker's South Landfill Phase 1 can be found on our project website (link). The design and construction quality assurance (i.e., monitoring and testing during liner installation) of the liner system is carried out by independent third parties. Proof of this independent oversight is provided to the MECP before a landfill is approved to receive any waste.

Further, independent third parties provide annual monitoring (i.e., surface water and groundwater monitoring) in and around the landfill site. These results are published in an Annual Monitoring Report

which is submitted to the MECP for review.

Comment - The levels of methane and other VOCs that are not captured as RNG by Walker. As the City of Thorold attempts to lower its GHGs, Walker emissions must also decrease, not increase over time. Where is Walker's plan to cut the facility's GHG emissions in half by 2030?

Response – I would be happy to discuss Walker's efforts to reduce GHG emissions and support the transition to a low carbon economy in more detail. In the interim, here are few examples for reference:

- Fuel efficiency optimization and electrification of our mobile equipment fleet,
- Creating sustainable products like <u>Grow Better Gardens</u> which replace peat in soil products with compost from municipal food waste programs (e.g. recovering food waste, protecting wetlands/peat bogs, sequestering carbon in soil),
- Producing Low Carbon Alternative Fuels (LCAF) from wood that would otherwise go to landfill to help steel mills/large emitters reduce their reliance on coal/GHG intensive fuels,
- Recovering landfill gas and producing renewable energy to help reduce Niagara's reliance on non-renewable energy sources.

With regard to your inquiry about landfill methane that is not captured by our landfill gas-to-energy system, we are highly motivated to minimize these emissions. Walker has been actively capturing landfill gas, converting it_into renewable energy sources, and displacing non-renewable energy sources for over 20 years in Niagara.

First, we are closely following the federal government's proposed landfill methane regulations, which I believe you reference above (i.e., "50% reduction by 2030"). While these regulations largely focus on landfills without gas collection systems, it will also ensure modern and progressive sites like Walker's are minimizing methane emissions. To further reduce any methane emissions from our site, we have been working closely with leading academic institutions and conducting research on advanced remote methane sensing techniques (i.e., drones) to improve monitoring, as well as the development of enhanced landfill cap designs that oxidize any methane that attempts to escape from the landfill.

Secondly, any methane that escapes into the atmosphere is a lost economic opportunity for Walker and the community. The methane we capture is turned into renewable energy that is used to:

- produce Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) and sell it into the Enbridge distribution network,
- generate renewable electricity to power Walker's Campus and sell it into the Niagara Peninsula Energy system, and
- deliver energy to the <u>GM Glendale Plant</u> to provide heat and electricity to this facility

Capturing methane forms a large component of our business and we, along with our community partners, are aligned in maximizing the collection of methane generated in our landfill to generate renewable energy.

I hope this information addresses your comments and as noted, I would happily schedule a time for phone call, virtual or in-person meeting to discuss your interest in the project further. Feel free to contact Elizabeth or I directly anytime.

Our company has been delivering its waste to Walker's South Landfill for years and I have personally attended at the Landfill and the Landfill is very well managed, from the health and safety regulations, training of new drivers entering the landfill for the first time, keeping their site neat and tidy so that the Landfill looks pleasing when you are driving by, minimizing odors for the hereby residents, to the compliance with all rules and regulations. Walker's South Landfill in Niagara has provided up to 500 job opportunities and contributed to the region's growth. Further to our conversation last week, please find a brief explanation of what an Environmental Assessment is and what Walker will be providing the library below.

Walker's South Landfill has been managing Niagara's waste for over forty years and is nearing its final capacity. Walker has started a planning process to develop the next phase (Phase 2) of the South Landfill which will provide additional disposal capacity over a twenty year period, supply renewable energy for the community by turning landfill gas into energy, and continue to support over 500 jobs in the Region.

As part of the planning process, Walker is doing an Environmental Assessment (EA). An EA is a process regulated by the Ontario Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) through the *Environmental Assessment Act*, which is designed to protect, conserve, and wisely manage Ontario's Environment.
